


FORS COVID-19 MOSAiCH study: Basic information

- **COVID-19 MOSAiCH study** started as part of the Swiss MOSAiCH/ISSP data collection in 2020 (second part / web mode)
- Vision: to follow people through the pandemic (panel design)
 ⇒ 3 waves (during lockdown / after / a year after)
- Target: private households in Switzerland, people 18+
- Focus on four broad areas: well-being, politics, work and workfamily reconciliation

FORS COVID-19 MOSAiCH study: Some more information on questionnaire content

- Well-being (W1-W3): experience with virus infection (own/broader network) and general health, worries and satisfaction, support
- Politics (W1-W3): trust, Covid measures and competencies
- Work (W1-W3): changes in work due to Covid measures (respondent & partner)
- Work & family reconciliation (W1-W3): task division (pre- and lockdown), shift in hours spent on tasks, childcare, change in partnership conflict

• W1: 55 items

- Adds in W2 (added 45 items): loneliness, economic well being/ future of work situation, voluntary work
- Adds in W3 (repeated W2 with some changes): vaccination, conspiracy/Covid deniers



FORS COVID-19 MOSAiCH study: Factsheets / Defacto articles

- **Aim:** to bundle the main results of the FORS COVID-19 MOSAiCH study and to reach a broader also (non-)academic audience
- Approach: descriptive ⇒ focus on various socio-demographic and other relevant variables


Four factsheets:

- Politics, fundamental rights and environmental concerns during the lockdown
- Work situation during the lockdown and expectations for the future
- Work-family compatibility during the lockdown
