

Dr. Michael Mirtl is an ecologist and environmental engineer, graduated at the University of Vienna, University of Agricultural Sciences (BOKU) and Technical University of Vienna. Dr. Mirtl is leading the eLTER ESFRI coordination for the Helmholtz Centre for Environmental Research – UFZ in Germany. He is coordinator of the eLTER Preparatory Phase Project, chairman of LTER-Europe, and co-chair of the ILTER (International Long Term Ecological Research). Until 2017, Dr. Mirtl was head of the Department for Ecosystem Research & Environmental Information Management of Environment Agency Austria and coordinated the Austrian contribution to the UNECE ICP on Integrated Monitoring of Air Pollution Effects on Ecosystems, which includes assessment of critical loads and dynamic modelling at longterm observation sites. He is specialized in analyses of ecosystem research data, development of ontologies and semantic mediation and integration of ecological and socio-economic research in LTSER. Since 2019 he formally represents eLTER as partner in the Global Ecosystem Research Infrastructure (GERI).
