1 Study

- For Scientific domain, select Social sciences. This
 ensures that the metadata scheme specific to Social
 sciences is used. FORS is automatically assigned as
 the responsible data service unit.
- Complete the mandatory metadata. To maximize the visibility of your study, fill in the metadata in several languages (English is mandatory).

· Complete the mandatory metadata about the dataset

3 Data file(s)

- Upload data file(s) in widely used and, if possible, non-proprietary formats and complete the metadata concerning each uploaded file
- i To make your dataset understandable, add all the nessarary files related to your dataset (codebooks, README files, syntaxes, technical instructions, collection instruments, etc.) paying attention to the naming conventions.

5 Usage license

 Confirm that you comply with Intellectual Property Rights and data protection law in order to choose an appropriate licence



- You can only deposit data on SWISSUbase if you hold the necessary rights to the data
 - ightarrow Consider the rules and regulations of your institutional framework, as well as your national and cantonal frameworks.
- Data must have been cleaned
 - → Clean your data by removing direct and/or indirect identifiers
- Informed consent involving the publication, preservation, sharing, and reuse of research data is required to deposit personal and/or sensitive data.
 - → Add a blank consent as a documentation file
- · Choose an appropriate licence
- i Each license option is described in further detail by clicking on each box. If you want to set restrictions and special permissions on the use of deposited data, the Closed Contract must be chosen.

6 Deposit data

- Choose whether to Enrich the data with more metadata and documentation or to Deposit your data with minimal metadata
- To make your data findable, increase their reuse potential, and comply with funder mandates, we highly recommend to enrich the data with metadata and adequate documentation taking into account good practices in data préparation.
